Fellow Rotarians,
 We have received inquiries about how best to help the victims of the fires that are devastating Northern California. Rotary District 5160 is working with the other Northern California Districts and Rotary International to set up a Donor Advised Fund in the Rotary Foundation to provide funds for rebuilding needs in the fire areas of all our districts. We will send out an announcement when the fund is ready to accept donations. Two other funds are available now to support individual fire areas. There may be other funds and we will notify you when information becomes available. As we become aware of clean-up and rebuilding efforts we will notify Rotary Clubs and members.

The first fund is to provide emergency food and shelter to victims of the Helena Fire near Weaverville in District 5160. The Weaverville Rotary Club has setup the Wildfire Emergency Relief Fund. Funds can be made payable to the Weaverville Rotary Foundation (EIN 68-0108505) and mailed to P.O. Box 589, Weaverville, CA 96093. Questions can be sent to James M. The other fund is the Lake Area Rotary Club Association (LARCA). This fund

is set up to provide support to the fire survivors and businesses in communities in District 5130 that include Napa, Sonoma and Lake counties.
